

2. - The Library Board will attempt to raise as much money as possible through Community Chest, memorial contributions, gifts or volunteer help. In this manner it can be more assured of continued support and backing of the community. 3. - The Superintendent of Schools, or his designated efficial, shall attend and participate in the discussions of the Library Board Meetings. He shall have due notice of all regular and special meetings at least one week prior to the meeting date. 4. - The library Board shall operate its business in accordance with the rules and regulations of the State Library Code. 5. - A tentative budget shall be presented to the School Board at least one month before its adoption. 6. - The Library Board shall assume the responsibility for Public Library service to the total area served by the School District and will - as conditions permit - establish branches in strategic places in the district.
