Monday, July 17th at 6:30 PM

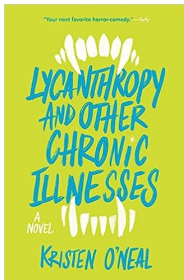

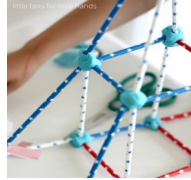

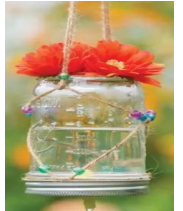
Teen Programs

For this craft, you are encouraged to recycle a jar that you already have. For example, you can use an old jam or spaghetti sauce jar. Registration is required for this craft.



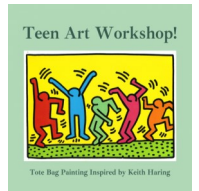

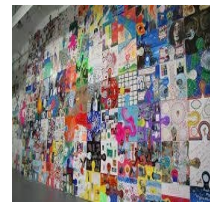
Teen Art Workshop: Keith Haring
