Did you know you can sign up for a Northampton Area Public Library card online?

Individuals living in the Northampton Area School District that are 12 years and older may apply online to receive a library card by mail. Once you receive your card you may access all of NAPL's Digital Resources. To utilize the card, individuals can use the library card number and the last four digits of the card as their PIN to access databases. Once we reopen bring your card and ID into the library to be validated for in house library use.
