Bake, cook, and taste with us on Mondays in the Community Room at 6:00 PM as we try some new themed recipes this Spring.

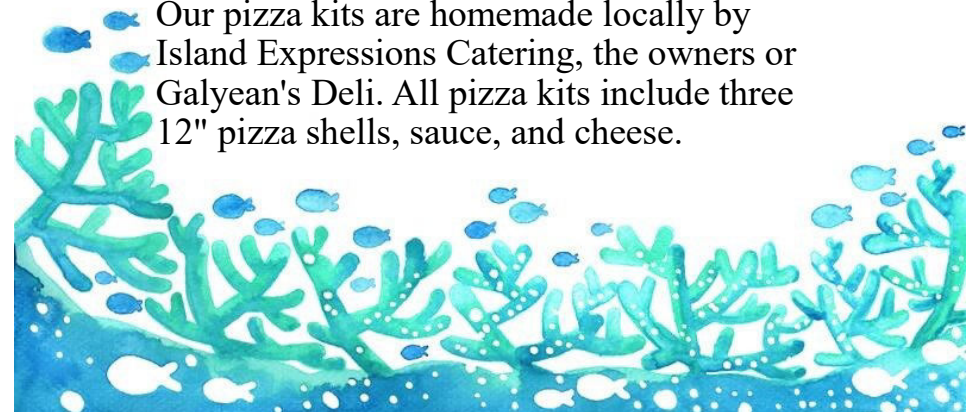
