Registration is required in order to receive this kit; be sure to include your grade when registering to receive the right one. Limit of 2.

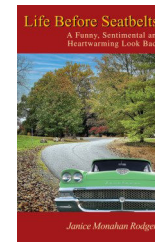


Janice Monahan Rodgers Presents: *Life Before Seatbelts!*

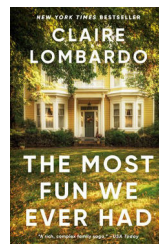
